**To be turned in with the final draft of your storymapping script*

- Freewriting – On your own notebook, free write about a place in your life. You might choose to share a story of place based on the significance and meaning this spot inhabits in your life, such as Bobbi’s digital story about her family dairy farm, or you can tell a story about place that relies not only on the place, but something that happened there, a moment in time, that makes the place important in your life.
- Draft #1 (300-500 words) – Double spaced for peer editing
- Peer Editing Worksheet X 2 (peer editors must include one student and someone over the age of eighteen)
- Final Draft – Typed or neatly handwritten in blue or black ink
- 5-10 digitized images or memorabilia items to help tell the story (photos, video clips, art work, news articles, etc.)
- Voiceover recorded via cell phone or landline at Gcast

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
